Description

YESA was engaged by Department of Finance through the Multilateral Division of CIDA to provide advice to the Canadian Director of the World Bank on the \$3.4B Chad Export Project. YESA directed and supervised the work of a team of three technical experts (pollution prevention and wastewater management, public administration, and community participation) to review the 19 volume Environmental Management Plan with regard to (a) the completeness of the EMP, (b) adequacy of the impact assessment process (c) appropriateness of the mitigation measures (d) issues not adequately dealt with in the EMP and (e) its adherence to the World Bank Group's operational policies and guidelines on Environmental Impact Assessment.

YESA gave a seminar in Ottawa for CIDA, DFAIT and the Department of Finance on the highlights of the review and key conclusions.
