Description

This research for CIDA focuses on the role of the state in the development process and the potential role for civil society organizations in the formation and implementation of environmental policy.

The project examines environmental assessment policy through an analysis of the impacts of environmental assessment (EA) regulatory regimes on the design and management of development projects. The report will provide a systematic review of EA-related government and project documents for four countries: Vietnam, Bolivia, Mozambique, and the Ukraine. All four are among the 25 countries of concentration identified in the *2005 International Policy Statement (IPS)*.
