Description

The Viet Nam-Canada Environment Project (VCEP) was a highly successful 10-year, \$20 million CIDA-funded project with the objective of building capacity for environmental protection and management in seven provinces and the National Environment Agency of Viet Nam. Specific project objectives were to strengthen the capacities of key national and provincial institutions in three areas:

- environmental monitoring;
- industrial and urban pollution management; and
- environmental impact assessment and planning.

Yap was the team leader and industrial pollution specialist for a results evaluation and design review mission of the VCEP program.

The mission's objectives were

1. To assess overall progress towards achieving the developmental results and the potential for achieving the outcomes at the end of the project;
2. To assess if, and how the design of VCEP II should be modified to adapt to government restructuring and to enhance its potential for achieving the developmental results more effectively and on time.
